
Figure 1. Types of transversal skills training at EURECA-PRO







Ensure knowledge transfer and solid research networks within and outside the alliance.

Consider inclusive and fair human resources policies, as well as knowledge-based economy approaches.








The study shows a high demand for the programme, emphasizing the need for additional training in management, impact, and cognitive skills. 69% of traning courses are currently offered in local languages and 82% are offered on-site and inperson. There is a need for more English-language courses and to push for online or hybrid enhancements of training.
